

BASKETBALL INNOVATIONS PLAYER/TEAM REGISTRATION FORM

COMPETITION DATES: There are several competitions commencing at different times throughout the year. Games are held on a Saturday afternoon and consist of two 25 minute halves. There are general byes for public holiday long weekends. e.g. Labour Day, Easter, WA Day, Queen's Birthday.

VENUE: The competition is held at the Craigie Leisure Centre 751 Whitfords Avenue Craigie which is near the corner of Whitfords Avenue and the Mitchell Freeway.

FINALS: All teams will participate in the finals series provided they are fully financial as of the last playing date of the regular round of fixtures.

WHO MAY JOIN: The competition is an adult competition and is open to men and women of all ages ranging from youth to upwards of 50 years. It caters for both beginners and experienced players. You can enter your own team or join an already established team.

REGISTRATION FEES: Registration covers nomination, public liability and personal accident insurance. Registration is usually \$25 per season. Discounts will apply if you register before a season commences or if you register late in a season.

WEEKLY GAME FEES: This is \$66 per team per week when games are played. The amount is divided among the players.

UNIFORMS: Basketball Innovations does not supply uniforms. Players are expected to purchase their own uniform by the third week after joining.

UMPIRES: Panel umpires are available for all matches. If you are interested in becoming an umpire contact Basketball Innovations via email: basketballinnovations@live.com.au All Basketball Innovations panel umpires are hired as casual employees. You must be eligible to work in Australia and will need to provide your tax file number to avoid being taxed at the highest rate.

GRADE DESCRIPTIONS: The descriptions below are only a guideline to the grades being offered during the current competition.

- **MENS A GRADE:** Experienced, very highly skilled men.
- **MENS B GRADE:** Experienced, highly skilled men.
- **MENS C GRADE:** Experienced, average to highly skilled men.
- **MENS D GRADE:** Experienced average skilled men.
- **MENS E GRADE:** Experienced moderately skilled to average skilled men.
- **MENS F GRADE:** Experienced moderately skilled men
- **MENS G GRADE:** Beginners and experienced moderately skilled players.
- **MENS E GRADE:** Beginners and moderately skilled players
- **WOMENS A GRADE:** Experienced, highly skilled women to moderately skilled women.
- **WOMENS B GRADE:** Intermediate skilled women.
- **WOMENS C GRADE:** Beginners and moderately skilled women.
- **MIXED A GRADE:** Experienced, highly skilled to moderately skilled men and women playing under special rules.
- **MIXED B GRADE:** Beginner to moderately skilled men and women playing under special rules.

Note: You can register for a mens grade and a mixed grade or a womens grade and a mixed grade. For the second team the season's registration fee is just \$10.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. The Player/Team Registration Form, together with the appropriate fee, must be paid before you will be accepted into the competition.
2. If you don't have a team to play in, you will be placed in a team with players similar to yourself. If you have joined with one or more friends, Basketball Innovations will endeavor to place you all in the same team.
3. From time to time Basketball Innovations will be promoting the competition via advertising pamphlets, advertisements and on its website. If you do not wish to have your photo included in advertising material, please advise the Basketball Innovations Administrator in writing when you register to play.
4. Basketball Innovations and Craigie Leisure Centre do not accept any responsibility for injuries, accidents or the loss or damage to personal property of players, officials or spectators.
5. Teams that have not registered all the players on their roster by the third game after joining the competition will be declared unfinancial and will not receive premiership points until this situation is rectified.
6. As many mixed teams draw players from several mens and womens teams, it will not always be possible to avoid fixture clashes.
7. Teams that forfeit games must notify the Competition Administrator by 6 pm on the Sunday prior to the game in order to avoid being penalized with a fine and a loss of premiership points.
